But this presentation isn't all gloom and doom! The good news is most injuries can be prevented when we wear eye protection. So what's "eye protection?"

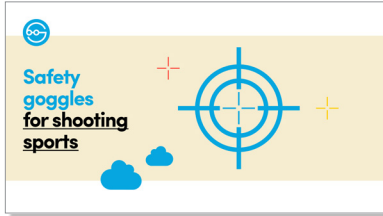
